BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
April 2, 2018

The Cherokee County Board of Commissioners held a regularly scheduled meeting in the Commissioners Boardroom of the Cherokee County Courthouse in Murphy, North Carolina on the 2nd day of April, 2018 at 6:30 o'clock p.m.

The following Commissioners were present for the meeting: Dr. Dan Eichenbaum, Chairman; Gary Westmoreland, Vice-Chair; C.B. McKinnon, member; Cal Stiles, member; and Roy Dickey, member. Also present were the following: Randy Wiggins, County Manager; Candy Anderson, Finance Director; and, Maria Hass, Assistant County Manager and Clerk to the Board.

Media present: Cherokee Scout, Local TV4, Hetch Your News, and WKRK. DVD copies of commission meetings may be purchased at Local TV4, or watched via the Facebook page of WKRK.

The invocation was given by Sheriff Palmer.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chairman Eichenbaum.

Agenda Adoption:

A Motion was made by Commissioner Stiles to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion seconded by Commissioner Dickey. Motion passed unanimously.

Public Forum:

During public forum, Ms. Linda Dubors complained about a free-roaming bull, saying that she has made four complaints to the sheriff's office, and now wants to know if the board of commissioners can help her resolve the situation. Sheriff Palmer told her that this meeting was an inappropriate place to discuss an investigation, but said that he would be glad to meet with her.

Ms. Aurelia Stone, manager of the Best Western hotel complained that local health and fire inspection laws do not apply to vacation rentals by owners (VRBO), and requested that the county adopt an ordinance or some local rules pertaining to VRBO's.

Mr. Gary Chamberlain came before the board to thank the board members who made personal financial contributions for the anti-litter campaign flyers, and also thanked Frankie Beal who volunteered and folded all of the flyers. The board thanked Mr. Chamberlain for all of his hard work.

Minutes:

A Motion was made by Commissioner Westmoreland to approve the March 19, 2018 Minutes. Motion seconded by Commissioner Dickey. Motion passed unanimously.

Finance and Budget:

- A Motion was made by Commissioner Westmoreland to approve a budget revision for Smart Start Grant Revenues in the amount of \$591, with no county match required. Motion seconded by Commissioner McKinnon. Motion passed unanimously.
- A Motion was made by Commissioner Stiles to approve a budget revision for an increase in state funds for health promotion in the amount of \$9,467, with no county match required. Motion seconded by Commissioner Dickey. Motion passed unanimously.

Budget revisions are available for public inspection, in the office of the Finance Director.

Old Business: Concerning Lambert Road, Road Naming Process

After discussion, and following a request by Mr. Anthony McCray to change the name of Lambert Road back to the original name of Lower Vengeance Creek Road, a Motion was made by Commissioner McKinnon to keep Lambert Road, as the official road name; and, to require any future request for the road name change to follow the current 911 Addressing Ordinance. Motion seconded by Commissioner Westmoreland. Motion passed unanimously.

New Business:

- Register of Deeds, Daphne Dockery, came before the board to discuss document recording cut-off time. A Motion was made by Commissioner McKinnon to table the item. Motion seconded by Commissioner Dickey. Motion passed unanimously. Ms. Dockery will gather additional information and come back to the board at a later date.
- A Motion was made by Commissioner Dickey to approve the tax releases. Motion seconded by Commissioner Westmoreland. Motion passed unanimously.
- A Motion was made by Commissioner Stiles to approve the tax refund report. Motion seconded by Commissioner McKinnon. Motion passed unanimously.
- A Motion was made by Commissioner McKinnon to approve the February NCVTS report. Motion seconded by Commissioner Westmoreland. Motion passed unanimously.
- A Motion was made by Commissioner McKinnon to participate in the April 14-28, 2018 NCDOT Litter Sweep. Motion seconded by Commissioner Stiles. Motion passed unanimously.
- A Motion was made by Commissioner Stiles to move the April 26th budget hearing to April 27th at 5:30 p.m. Motion seconded by Commissioner Dickey. Motion passed unanimously.
- A Motion was made by Commissioner Westmoreland to schedule a budget work session for May 31st at 6:30 p.m. Motion seconded by Commissioner McKinnon. Motion passed unanimously.

- A Motion was made by Commissioner McKinnon to schedule a Special Meeting on June 28th at 6:30 p.m. for adoption of the FY18-19 budget ordinance. Motion seconded by Commissioner Dickey. Motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Items:

During commissioner items, Commissioner Westmoreland said that he and the county manager had met with the two towns and Tri-County Community College and discussed infrastructure needs.

Commissioner Stiles said that there was a good turnout at the forest service meeting in Andrews on Friday and that many ideas were shared, concerning the forest service plan.

Commissioner McKinnon asked about the status of the MedTrans lease.

Closed Session:

A Motion was made by Commissioner Dickey to go into closed session pursuant to §143-318.11. (a) (6), to consider applications for the county attorney position. Motion seconded by Commissioner McKinnon. Motion passed unanimously.

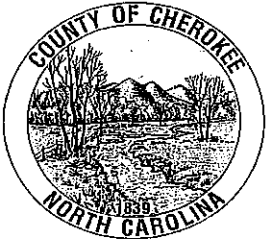
During closed session, the board interviewed two applicants.

After returning to open session, a Motion was made by Commissioner Stiles to appoint Darryl Brown as county attorney, and to approve a budget revision for professional services, not to exceed \$12,500 for the current fiscal year, and to approve the following provisions:

- \$5000 annual retainer-Due upon hiring, and again at the beginning of each fiscal year (July 1)
- \$2500 monthly (\$250 an hour for a guaranteed minimum of 10 hours per month)
- \$175 an hour for all hours over 10
- \$500 annual allocation for books relevant to county representation
- \$12,000 annual fee for on call counsel for sheriff's department (\$6000 payable at the beginning of the fiscal year and \$6000 payable at the beginning of the calendar year)
- County to cover the cost of travel and training for annual county attorney conference and annual sheriff's conference

Motion seconded by Commissioner Westmoreland. Motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the board, a Motion was made by Commissioner Westmoreland to adjourn. Motion seconded by Commissioner Dickey. Motion passed unanimously.

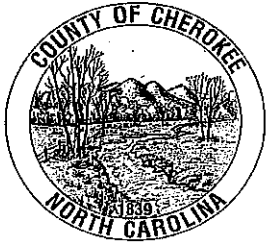

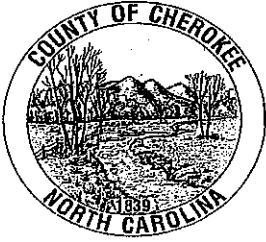


Capital Items Request Using Available Revenue

The Cherokee County Detention Center has reached their revenue goal for the 2018 budget year. We are asking to use the available revenue brought in for the month of February, March, April and May to purchase the capital items we have requested in our 2019 budget. The first set of items we are requesting are the two 2018 Chevrolet 4x4 Tahoe's for Captain and Lieutenant to utilize. These vehicles will replace the two that are on loan from the Sheriff Department at this time. These new vehicles will be utilized for many things such as transporting employees during inclement weather to and from work, Federal Marshall Transports during inclement weather, also when Federal Marshalls request for escorts to aide with transporting Federal Inmates to and from court. The estimate of each vehicle is: 2018 Tahoe \$37,500.00, Accessories \$5,000.00 each which includes cage, lights, radio and etc., additional DMV cost, and Taxes. Another capital item we would like to purchase is a new 2018 Transport Van estimate for Van is \$30,300 and accessories estimate is \$18,000.00 which includes a new van cell, new video equipment for the Van, lights, radio and etc. We also would like to utilize this to buy new Officer Radios for the Detention Center which the estimated cost is \$ 12,500.00. A new fingerprint machine for our Detention Center which the estimated cost is \$ 21,000.00 and comes with a 1yr service agreement. A new kitchen fryer for our Detention Center Kitchen which the estimated cost is \$ 17,000.00 since the one we have currently no longer works. A new Road Crew truck which is estimated \$25,000.00 and an additional DMV cost and Taxes are not included. A new Detention Center 2018 Ford Transport Car that is estimated at \$21,500.00 and additional cost for cage is and labor is \$1,250.00 and additional-DMV and taxes are not included. Last items we would like to include is our own Pistols for the Detention side to replace the ones we have on loan from the Sheriff's Office side at the moment, holsters for the pistols, ammo for the pistols, rifle and shotgun, a gun safe to store all of the weapon inventory and a vest for each transport Officer that is certified to carry a weapon for transports which the estimate for all of these items is \$ 23,400.00. All of these items I have mentioned above will come out of our 2019 capital items budget request which come to a grand total of \$253,700.00. Also with the left over available revenue money we can purchase a couple of A/C units to have on stand by for when one needs to be replaced.


