Motion made by Commissioner Ledford and seconded by Commissioner Conley to modify the agenda as follows:

Adopt Agenda

Motion made by Commissioner Conley and seconded by Commissioner Ledford to adopt the agenda as modified. Motion passed unanimously.

Public Hearing for Comments on FY 27 Proposed Budget

- Motion made by Commissioner Bryant and seconded by Commissioner Ledford to open the public hearing. Motion passed unanimously.
- During public comments, Jan Griggs questioned Vincent Valuations and shared concerns of an issue with the firm in Pender County
- Motion made by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Conley to close the public hearing. Motion passed unanimously.

Public Comment Period

Budget and Finance

Motion made by Commissioner Conley and seconded by Commissioner Adams to approve Cherokee County Schools request for use of Article 40/42 sales tax in the amount of \$9,125 for HVAC Control software upgrade at Andrews Middle School and Martin's Creek. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Conley and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that exempt DSS employees sitting with a child at the Cottage outside of normal working hours receive 1.5-hour stipend for each hour worked, and 4-hours for each holiday worked. Non-exempt employees would also receive the 4-hour stipend when working on a holiday. Motion passed unanimously.

New Business

Motion made by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Bryant to appoint Sandra Daley as Chairperson of the Tourism Development Authority. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Conley and seconded by Commissioner Ledford to appoint Commissioner Bryant to the Southwestern Rural Planning Organization (RPO). Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Bryant to appoint Commissioner Ledford to the VAYA Health Board. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Ledford and seconded by Commissioner Conley to re-appoint Dr. Grady Hester to the Cherokee County Board of Health to serve in the Veterinarian Position. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Ledford and seconded by Commissioner Conley to re-appoint Mike Bradberry to the Cherokee County Board of Health in the Community Member position. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Bryant and seconded by Commissioner Conley to appoint Al Lovingood to the Tri-County Community College Board of Trustees. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Conley to approve the Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC) Annual Plan and Certification. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Ledford and seconded by Commissioner Bryant to approve the 2026 Juneteenth Proclamation. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Bryant to approve a resolution rescinding the July 2025 Residual Tax Value of Personal Property Policy and adopting the 2026 policy for Residual Tax Value of Personal Property. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Conley to approve the

Tax Releases, Tax Refund Report, and NCVTS, as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Ledford and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that all resolutions being sent for legislative support will lay in review for 30 days and a public hearing will be scheduled following end of review period. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Bryant and seconded by Commissioner Conley to send a letter to SBA Communications Corporation requesting engagement and inventory review to bridge critical infrastructure gaps. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Conley to approve a Contract for legal services for the Office of the Sheriff. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Conley to adopt the Parks and Recreation Fee Policy for For-Profit Use. For-profit organizations will be required to pay Cherokee County 10% of receipts and provide proof of a \$2 million insurance policy. Motion passed unanimously.

County Manager Items

The county manager gave an update on the landfill mechanic's building project.
