• AVERAGING 20-25 TRIPS/DAY- SIIMILAR TO FY21

DEMAND RESPONSE -

- DEMAND RESPONSE RIDERSHIP IS UP- THIS QTR OF FY22 IS HIGHER THAN ANY IN FY21. WE'VE PERFORMED 5,300 TRIPS ALREADY THIS QTR
- CONTRACTED SERVICES- PROVIDED SERVICES FOR VALLEY VIEW NURSING HOME VOCATIONAL REHAB, IOI, AND LOCAL DSS

MEDICAID MANAGED CARE NEMT UPDATE-

- WE ARE CONTRACTED WITH ONE CALL.
- TRANSFORMATION KICKED OFF JULY 1<sup>st</sup>,
- WE HAVE HAD THREE REQUESTS FOR TRIPS. TWO WERE FOR DAYS AND TIMES OUTSIDE OF OUR SERVICE PARAMETERS. ONE WAS FOR A PASSENGER WE ALREADY HAD SCHEDULED THROUGH LOCAL DSS.
- WE PERFORMED 605 TRIPS THIS QTR FOR PASSENGERS WITH TRADITIONAL MEDICAID TRANSPORTATION THROUGH LOCAL DSS.
- MODIVCARE IS STILL INTERESTED IN CONTRACTING WITH CCT. NO TERMS HAVE BEEN AGREED UPON.

WHEN APPLYING FOR ROAP, WE'RE ASKED TO RECEIVE RECOMMENDATIONS FROM OUR TAB ON HOW TO USE THE ROAP FUNDS.

(EXPLANATION of ROAP PROGRAMS AND ELIGIBLE TRIPS)

CURRENTLY, THE COUNTY RECEIVES FUNDS AND CHEROKEE COUNTY TRANSIT USES THE FUNDS TO SUPPORT ROAP ELIGIBLE TRIPS ON AN ALLOCATED COST PER MILE BASIS. PUBLIC FARES ARE STILL CHARGED AND USED TO SUPPORT EXPENSES. TRANSIT USES DEMOGRAPHICS AND TRIP PURPOSES TO DOCUMENT WHICH FUNDING SOURCE IS USED.

> • ROAP REPORTS ARE PERFORMED PERIODICALLY TO SEE HOW MANY TRIPS/ MILES ARE BEING USED AND HOW MUCH OF THE FUNDS ARE STILL AVAILABLE. AT THE END OF FY22, THE COUNTY HAS THE OPTION TO RETURN UNSPENT FUNDS OR TO RETAIN THEM FOR THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR FOR ROAP ELIGIBLE TRIPS.
