SPECIAL CALLED WORKSESSION

A Special Called Worksession of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners was held in the Commissioner's Boardroom 342, of the Cherokee County Courthouse, on the 12th day of September, 2016 at 6:30 o'clock p.m.

The purpose of the meeting was to review the current Solid Waste Ordinance, and discuss needed revisions. The group worked together to remove articles and clauses that are no longer relevant to Cherokee County; and added language for fines, penalties and legal enforcement of the ordinance. The county attorney will draft the revised ordinance, and the board will then schedule a public hearing to receive questions or comments from members of the public.
